Get the Funds You Need to Help Your **Small Business** Succeed

Qualifying small businesses in Montgomery County now have access to \$2,500 to \$25,000 in grants through the MicroEnterprise Grant Program. With an emphasis on serving socially and economically disadvantaged businesses, the program delivers working capital that helps you succeed.

More Than a Grant

Participating businesses will also receive continued support through vital business development resources and auxiliary programs, including CAP Training, Project Hire, and mentoring. Additionally, applicants will be added as a county vendor, presenting greater opportunities and public exposure.

How does the MicroEnterprise Grant Program work?



Support

Receive continued assistance and take advantage of business development resources, including entrepreneurship courses, CAP training, MBAC and the SBDC.



Fund

Qualifying small businesses can access a grant of up to \$25,000 through the program. Simply determine your needs, visit **mcomicro.com**, download the application, and submit your request.



Grow

Use your grant award to help your business succeed. Whether you need to purchase equipment, fund research, or bolster inventory, the funds are available to help you grow.

Does my business qualify for the program?

To qualify for a grant through the MicroEnterprise Grant Program, your business must meet the following basic eligibility guidelines:*

- Small, for-profit business with fewer than 5 employees
- Sales revenue under \$500,000
- Established for at least 12 months
- Store-front business, not home-based/2nd income

What terms apply to the program?

Funds awarded through the program are offered as a working capital equity grant. Grant amounts range from \$2,500 - \$25,000. Participating businesses must be current on taxes and contribute 10% cash equity or in-kind for targeted funds. Need-based business development services may be required, based on assessment. Participants must be willing to become mentors for future applicants.*
